1. Australia Region

A couple of clubs have ongoing support projects such as the Smith Family Appeal which is where a club support the primary age school students who are disadvantaged in providing books and other school necessities; One club makes an annual donation to a national kidney foundation. Most of the clubs are in recess due to corona virus lockdown.

2. Japan East Region

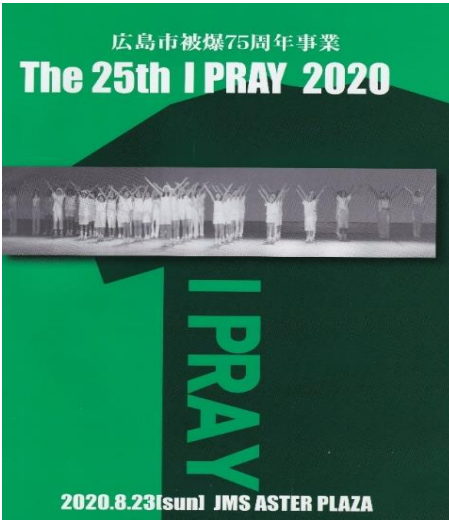
Donation of Tokyo Green Club wheelchair to Group Home Anshin-En

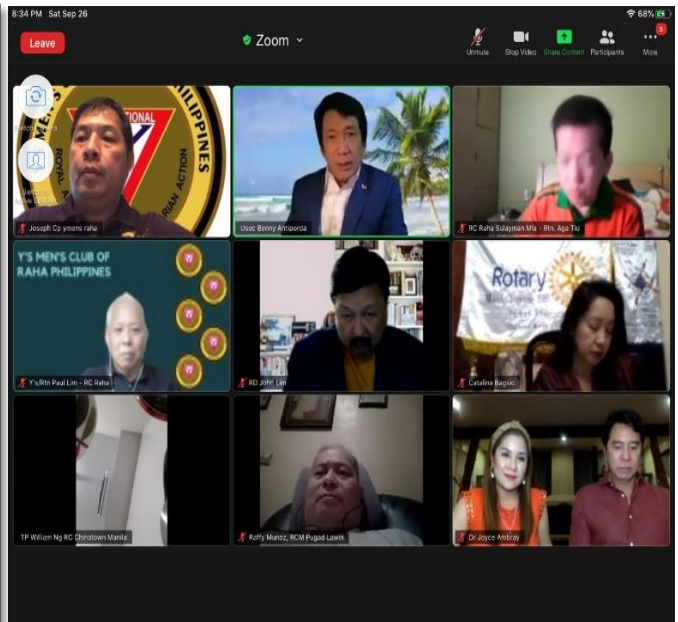
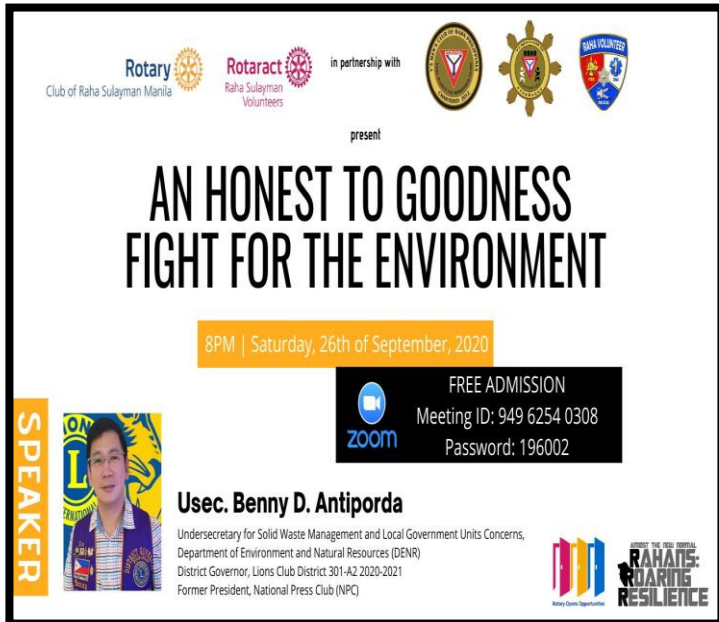
