### We also to part in YMI Week4Waste Project:

1. North District: First, combined with Taoyuan Tinfun Protectory to carry on annual "Offer warm in cold winter" in January. around 40 members, Menettes and Y'slings not only offered food and clothes etc. but also cleaned the surrounding environment and restored the street clean. Second, hold a medical lecture combined with park clean-up on Menettes' Activity in April. Around 50 members of Menettes participated.

2. Center District: Together with Changhua YMCA, around 60 Y's members, Menettes and Y'slings attended the wetland clean-up activity in March. Many plastic bags, large waste, glass, dangerous needles were picked up. There were 170.5kg of general waste, 169.2kg of recovery material, 16kg of large waste, total 355.7kg of marine debris which will let the wetland become a clean natural landscape.

For the youth part, we have always encouraged Y'sling to participate in Y's activities, and we will definitely hold a youth camp every year. This year, we had held a youth camp in Taichung on 30–31January.

I want to thank all RSDs and Y's Men members and Menettes for their cooperation and the hard work of the cadres. Hope the Y's Men will grow stronger and last forever in Taiwan!

# THE LOVE OF SUPPORT ~ Y'S MENETTES IN TAIWAN

In the history of Y's Men International Taiwan Region, a spouse of a Y's Man is called a Y's Menette and they form an auxiliary to the local Y's Men's Club. Menettes often assist, contribute and support Y's Men without complaint due to the needs of their spouse, and in such a consistent "love" mood, accumulate a deep bond of friendship and strength. Over the years, Y's Menettes in Taiwan, both domestically and internationally, have actively participated in Y's Men's various ministries, and the results are obvious to all. As the number of Y's Men Club Members is shrinking in an all-round way, how to focus on bringing out its possible unique characteristics within the established Y's organizational structure is a top priority.

#### In terms of expansion

In his 2019 term, IPRD Tony Liao proposed a three-year-plan to expand Y's Menettes Club, i.e. to have each local Y's Menettes Club registered to realign with Y's Menettes International. Menette Sdi Feng, who is the wife of H. K. Chen, IBC RSD of Taiwan Region was invited as the Artistic Director to design a visual identity for Taiwan Y's Menettes. This plan was strongly supported by RD Frank Tsai, RDE Kevin Su, and all the directors and supervisors. IPRD Tony Liao had 12 local Y's Menettes Clubs completed registration in the 2019/2020 term; RD Frank Tsai expects to achieve the goal of registering all of them before the expiration of his term in June 2021.

In addition, before RD Frank Tsai taking office, his wife Helen Tsai started planning the establishment of a new club. She took concrete actions to support the expansion plan. Thanks to Helen's efforts, the Y's Women's Club of Taichung EverGrace was established on August 16, 2020, with a total of 22 club members; making the number of YMI Taiwan Region members increased from 498 to 520. Helen showed her "supporting love", and the result is remarkable!

#### Image of Y's Menettes

The visual identity for Menettes in Taiwan is the "Silk Scarf". This idea came from the motto of Y's Men and was designed by Sdi-Feng. The element of this design is to connect the logos of Y's Menettes and to make a cross with the spirit of Christ's love. The four cardinal directions are the metaphor of the globe and the regions. The intertwined ropes and nods linking the four corners, are the symbol of Y's Menettes' unity and sustainability. The color scheme design is based on the evergreen in Taiwan and the friendliness of people; the pure fragrance of lilies will be endless. The Y's Menettes will help Y's Men to pass on the love and service to the society. It will never end.

The "Silk Scarf" designed by Sdi Fong is made of pure silk with high quality, and the packaging and finished products are comparable to international famous brands. It is elegant but not expensive, and it is suitable as a gift or for personal use. Taiwan Region Menettes Committee specially reserved 50 pieces for charity sale at the Area / Regional Convention in coming August; the proceeds from the charity sale will be injected into the 2022 Fund. Hopefully, with the support of love by Menettes, Y's in all Regions will be stronger and stronger.

### Loving and Caring

The Y's Menette Lily Chen Welfare Fund was established by Charming Shen in 2019, in memory of his beloved wife, who passed away in January 2019 due to sickness. The fund was formed to raise awareness of good health, assist members in providing medical aid and promote education among others. On April 24, 2021, in response to Charming Shen's concern for Menettes, the North District Governor Shih-Chin Li specially held the "Event of Menettes in the North District", to give a medical lecture on the topic of vision health at the Keelung City Council Multimedia Audiovisual Center. APE Charming Shen, on behalf of family members of "The Y's Menette Lily Chen Welfare Fund"

sponsored the event with a cost of NT\$10,000.

The Event of Menettes in the North District was hosted by DG Shih-Chin Li.

PAP Tung-Ming Hsiao attended and provided guidance.

PRD Aisha Huang gave a few statements to emphasize the importance of "cleaning".


# FOUR NEW CLUBS FROM MYANMAR SUCCESSFULLY JOINED Y'S MEN'S FAMILY

Amidst the turmoil in Myanmar, four new Myanmar Clubs were successfully chartered on June 5, 2021. A Joint Hybrid Charter Ceremony was held on the same day. AP David Lua, ISG Jose Varghese, Maung Maung Win, National General Secretary of Myanmar YMCAs were invited to address the gathering. IPIP Jennifer Jones, IPAP Hiroyuki Tanaka, Nam Bon Woon General Secretary of Asia & Pacific Alliance of YMCAs gave congratulatory message to all clubs RD Joan Wong and DG Peter Tay hosted the installation of charter club presidents and induction of club members respectively. Other international leaders: IPE Dr. Kim Sung Chae and APE Ohno Ben Tsutomu sent a congratulatory letter and video respectively though they were unable to attend. A written prayer message for Myanmar from IP Jacob Kristensen was sent to all new clubs after the ceremony.

The four new clubs namely Y's Men's Club of Tawwin Myanmar, Y's Men's Club of Mandalay, Y's Men's Club of Loikaw and Y's Men Club of Myitkyina added a total of 70 members to Southeast Asia Region. Clubs from within the Region provided the cross-border sponsorship, namely Y's Men's Club of Alpha Chapter, Singapore; Y's Men's Club of Chiang Mai, Thailand; Y's Men's Club of Island East, Hongkong; Y Service Club Lumbini, Nepal, Y's Men's Club of Tsim Sha Tsui, Hong Kong and Y's Men's Club of North West, Hong Kong. Sponsor club presidents Daniel Ng, Wichitra Khuenkhai, Leo Chiu, Gabriel Lee and Deepak Bhandari together with club representatives Tony Chan attended the ceremony and presented the table flagstand, bell and gavel to each of the four new clubs.

Since October 2020, a Special Area & Regional Extension Team for Myanmar was formed in the Southeast Asia for the establishment of Y's Men's clubs in Myanmar. The team included AP David Lua, ASD-EMC/PAP Edward Ong, ASD-YL Kohei Yamada, RD Joan Wong, RSD-Ext James Kong, DG Peter Tay, RSD-YL/DGE Rachan Maneekarn and RS/DGE Deepak Bhandari. Several meetings with all clubs were held and an orientation session was organized on May 15, 2021. Although the original charter date in February 2021 was postponed due to a sudden change of political situation. The utmost effort given by National YMCA of Myanmar in the extension effort no doubt led to the successful charter of the four new clubs.

# YMI ASP PARTNERS WITH MAKATI YMCA FOR RENEWABLE ENERGY

The Y's Men International Asia Pacific Area (YMI-ASP) signed a Climate Action Partnership with the YMCA of Makati Inc. (Makati YMCA) in the Philippines for a Renewable Energy Project last June 19, 2021.

ASP co-funded the installation of a Solar PV System on the Makati YMCA Building which aims to reduce carbon emission from energy consumption. In return, Makati YMCA will support the funding of ASP Projects on Environment in the next five years.

In his message, AP David Lua expressed that ASP finds worthy to support this project in commemoration of the 100th Anniversary of Y's Men International and is the first of its kind of a YMI-YMCA partnership model. Makati YMCA Chairman, Dr. Rosalio Torres mentioned that this is one of the flagship projects of Makati YMCA in commemoration of its Golden Anniversary this year.

The historical virtual signing ceremony was graced by YMI and YMCA Leaders from International and Asia Pacific Area; YMI IPIP Jennifer Jones, YMI Secretary General Jose Varghese and YMCA General Secretary of Asia Pacific Alliance Mr. Nam Boo Won were among those present.
