They maintained a social distance, ventilation, temperature monitoring, and hand disinfection. Only lunch boxes and cooked pork miso soup were arranged. The children made Halloween candy pots.

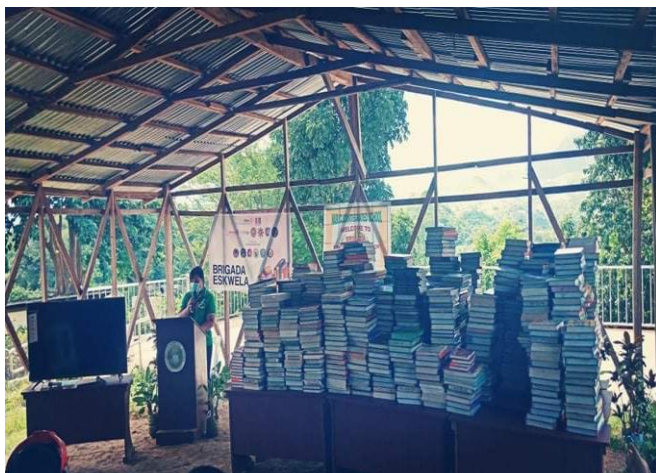

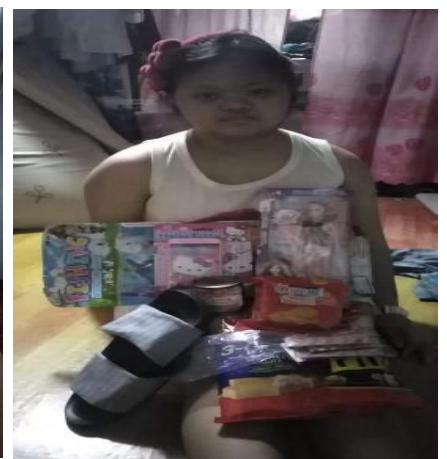
